

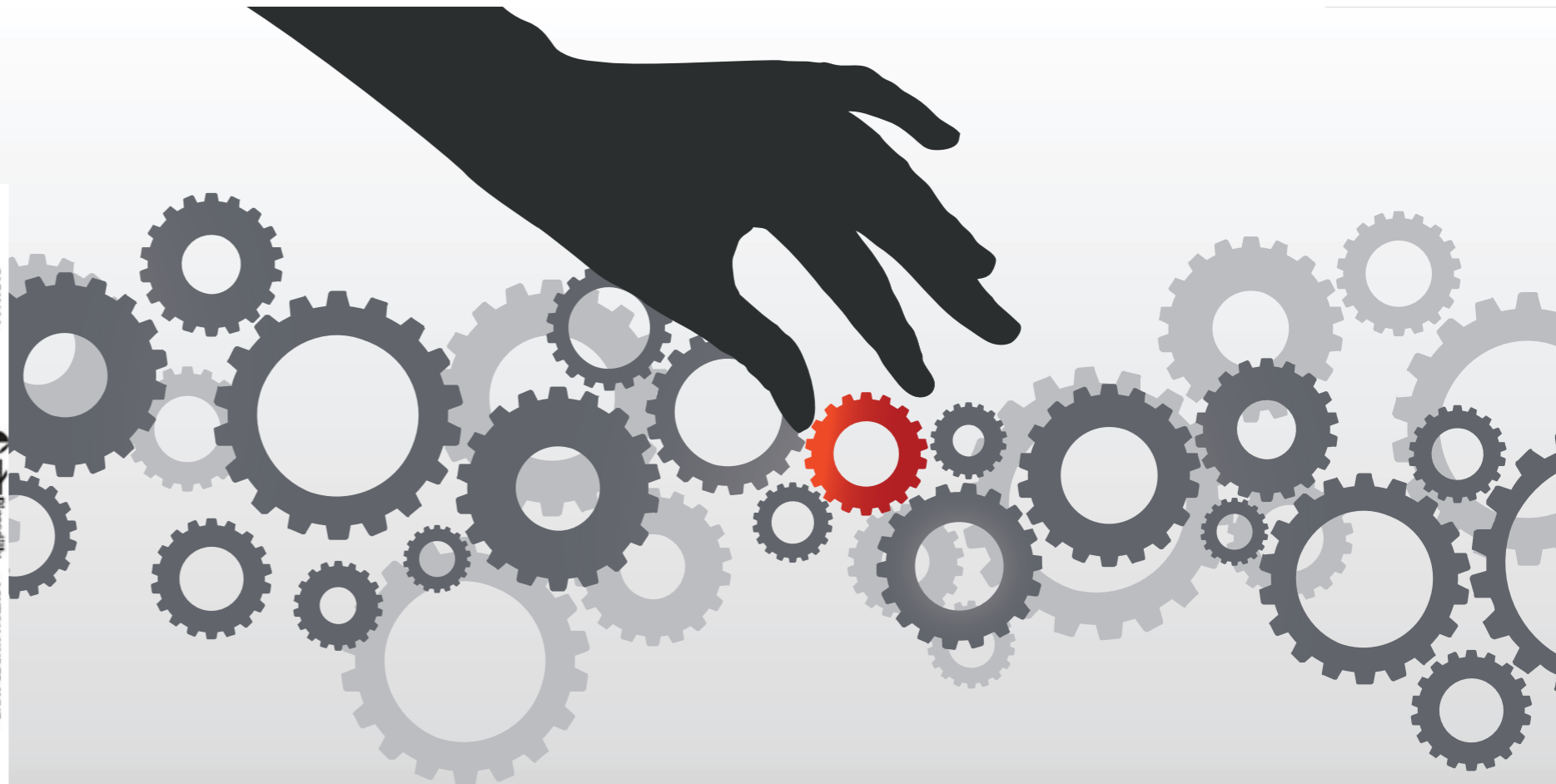
How to find The Bridgewater Hall
